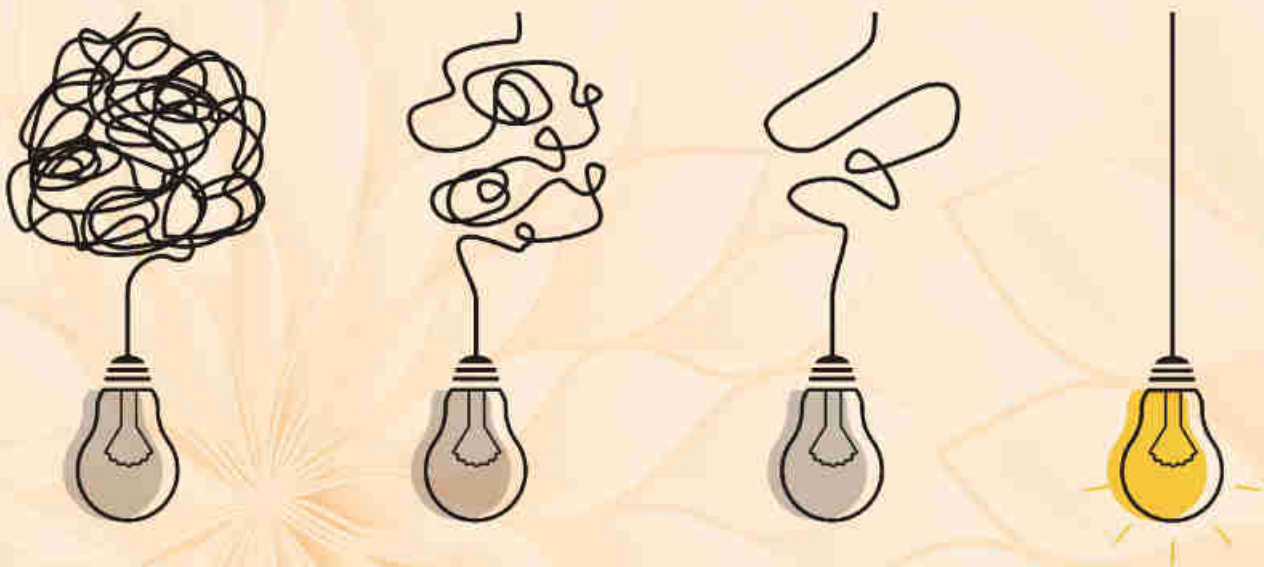
What is simplicity?
